

The International Affairs Budget Working for Indiana

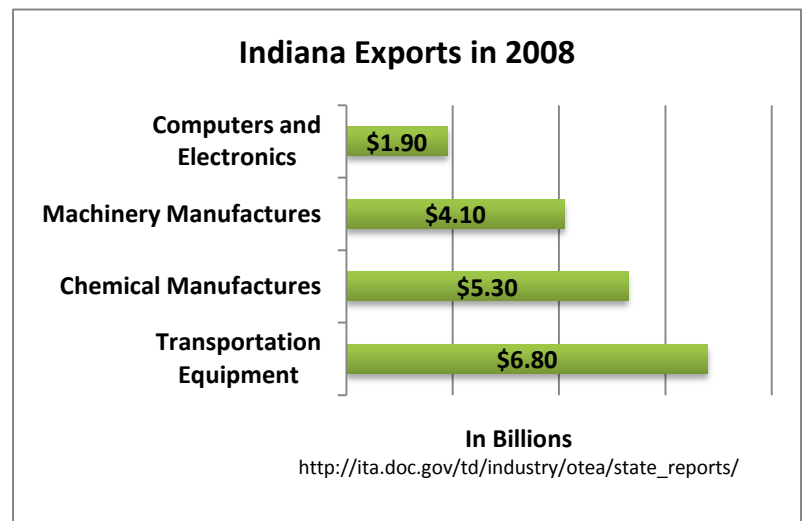
Employment

- Trade supported 635,184 jobs in Indiana in 2006, or 17.5% of total jobs, up from 10% in 1992.¹ Nearly one-fifth (19.7%) of all manufacturing workers in Indiana depended on exports for their jobs.²
- In 2007, 144,100 people in Indiana were employed by U.S. affiliates of companies that are at least 50% foreign-owned.³



Trade

- Indiana exported \$26.5 billion in merchandise to 196 foreign markets in 2008. Indiana's largest market in 2008 was Canada (\$10.6 billion), followed by Mexico (\$2.1 billion), the United Kingdom (\$2.0 billion), France (\$1.4 billion), and Germany (\$1.3 billion).⁴
- In 2007, 6,057 companies exported goods from Indiana. Of these, 85% were small- and medium-sized enterprises with fewer than 500 employees.⁵
- Agricultural exports are important to Indiana's economy, totaling \$3.7 billion and supporting about 42,857 jobs in 2008.⁶
- Since 2005, the U.S. Export-Import Bank has financed over \$657 million in exports from 101 companies in 41 communities in Indiana.⁷



Education

- In 2007-2008, 8,990 Indiana students studied abroad, an 11.2% increase over the previous academic year.⁸
- From 2008-2009, three Indiana institutions sent more than 80% of their students abroad at some point during their undergraduate careers.⁹
- During 2008-2009, 17,098 international students were enrolled in Indiana colleges and universities and contributed \$433.6 million to the Indiana economy.¹⁰

International Assistance Programs



- Since 1961, 2,846 Peace Corps volunteers from Indiana have served in dozens of countries overseas.¹¹
