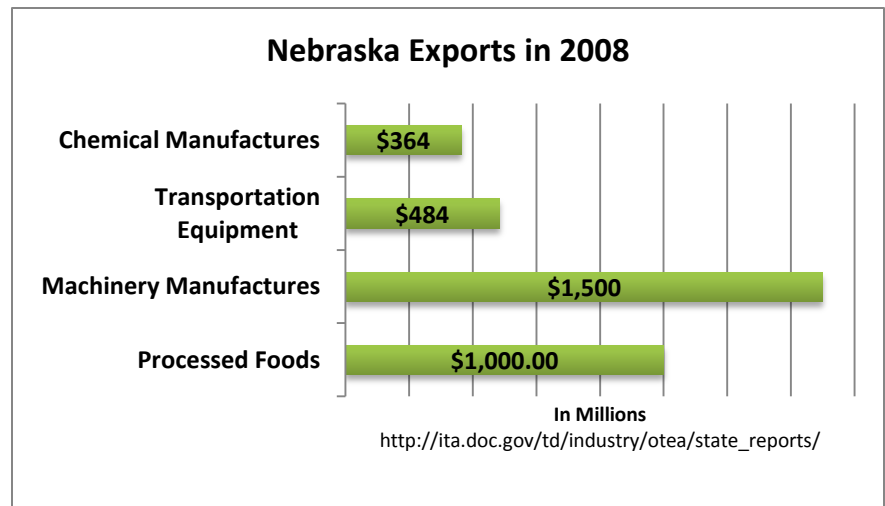
Employment

- Trade supported 222,965 jobs in Nebraska in 2006, or 18.6% of total jobs, up from 11.2% in 1992.¹ Over one-eighth (12.9%) of all manufacturing workers in Nebraska depended on exports for their jobs.²
- In 2007, 23,700 people in Nebraska were employed by U.S. affiliates of companies that are at least 50% foreign-owned.³



Trade

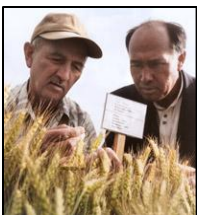
- Nebraska exported \$5.4 billion in merchandise to 176 foreign markets in 2008 (a 132% increase over 2004). Nebraska's largest market in 2008 was Canada (\$1.5 billion), followed by Mexico (\$1.1 billion), Japan (\$398 million), China (\$199 million), and South Korea (\$149 million).⁴
- In 2007, 1,214 companies exported goods from Nebraska. Of these, 80% were small- and medium-sized enterprises with fewer than 500 employees.⁵
- Agricultural exports are important to Nebraska's economy, totaling \$5.9 billion and supporting about 68,339 jobs in 2008.⁶
- Since 2005, the U.S. Export-Import Bank has financed over \$186 million in exports from 38 companies in 14 communities in Nebraska.⁷



Education

- In 2007-2008, 1,799 Nebraska students studied abroad, a 15.6% increase over the previous academic year.⁸
- During 2008-2009, 4,335 international students were enrolled in Nebraska colleges and universities and contributed \$88.6 million to the Nebraska economy.⁹

International Assistance Programs



- Since 1961, 1,201 Peace Corps volunteers from Nebraska have served in dozens of countries overseas.¹⁰
