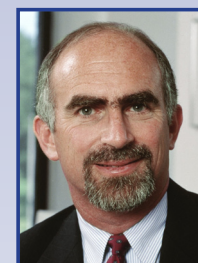

Bruce Jentleson



Bruce Jentleson is on the National Security Advisory Committee for Obama for America and Professor of Public Policy and Political Science at Duke University, where he served as Director of the Terry Sanford Institute of Public Policy. He has also served as Senior Advisor to the U.S. State Department Policy Planning Director, and as foreign policy advisor to Vice President Al Gore. He is currently a member of the Responsibility to Protect Working Group, co-chaired by Madeleine Albright and Rich Williamson, and Co-Director of Amidst the Revolutions: U.S. Strategy in a Changing Middle East. Jentleson has published numerous books and articles on foreign policy and has appeared on the Lehrer News Hour, BBC, Al Jazeera, and NPR.

Honorable Tim Pawlenty



Tim Pawlenty served as Governor of Minnesota from 2003 to 2011, and is a former Republican presidential candidate. As Governor, Pawlenty led business delegations to many countries including China, Czech Republic, India, Israel, Mexico, and Poland, in an effort to improve his state's connections to global markets. Since leaving office, he has remained active on foreign policy issues, serving as an election monitor in Tunisia last year for the International Republican Institute. In the 2007 to 2008 term, he served as chairman of the National Governors Association. Governor Pawlenty until recently served as national co-chair for Mitt Romney's presidential campaign.

General Anthony Zinni



General Anthony Zinni is a distinguished national leader who dedicated nearly four decades to serving his country in uniform. After joining the U.S. Marine Corps, General Zinni's military service took him to over 70 countries, and he served tours of duty in Okinawa and Germany as well as two tours in Vietnam. From 1997-2000, General Zinni served as the Commander in Chief of U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM). Since his retirement from the Marine Corps, General Zinni has continued to serve his country as a U.S. Peace Envoy in the Middle East and as the Special Envoy to the Henri Dunant Centre for Humanitarian Dialogue. General Zinni served as the founding Co-Chair of the U.S. Global Leadership Coalition's National Security Advisory Council, which now numbers over 100 retired three- and four-star generals and flag officers.

David Brody (Moderator)



David Brody is an Emmy Award-winning veteran news journalist currently covering the White House and interviewing national newsmakers across the country as the Chief Political Correspondent for Christian Broadcasting Network News. His recent one-on-one interviews have crossed the ideological spectrum, ranging from President Obama to Senator McCain, from Rudy Giuliani to Hillary Clinton. David's political blog, *The Brody File*, has been featured in The New York Times, The Los Angeles Times and The Washington Post. He also offers weekly political analysis for CNN and has appeared frequently as a roundtable panelist on NBC's *Meet The Press*.
