We are concerned that this group of Afghans – individuals who qualify for Priority 2 refugee status – could be left behind. These civilian operations – driven by Afghans working on U.S. funded projects – have been vital for America's national security and for empowering millions of women and girls. These individuals who stood directly with America face grave danger now, and we must stand with them and also prioritize them for U.S.-led evacuations.
