

AMERICA AND THE WORLD: HOW NEW MEXICO WINS

High-tech products lead New Mexico's exports to destinations like Mexico, China, and Columbia. New Mexico exports a total of \$15.3 billion worth of goods and services annually, which help to support over 230,000 jobs in the state.

BOOSTING NEW MEXICO JOBS & EXPORTS

In New Mexico, **230,000 jobs** are supported by trade, representing **20%** of all jobs in the state.

In 2023, **1,246 companies** exported goods from New Mexico of which **84%** were **small- and medium-sized enterprises**. Additionally, **22,000 people** were employed by affiliates of international companies.

New Mexico exports about \$15.3 billion in goods and services to overseas markets each year. New Mexico's top export markets are:

- Mexico (\$7.1 billion)
- China (\$3.1 billion)
- Malaysia (\$2.8 billion)
- Vietnam (\$775 million)
- Japan (\$254 million)

Agricultural exports are important to New Mexico's economy, totaling **\$912 million** annually, according to the USDA.

Since 2014, the **U.S. Export-Import Bank** has supported **\$72 million** in exports from 11 companies in New Mexico.

EDUCATION + VOLUNTEERISM

From 2024-2025, **2,943 international students** were enrolled in New Mexico colleges and universities and contributed **\$85 million** to the New Mexico economy.

Since 1961, **2,305 Peace Corps volunteers** from New Mexico have served in dozens of countries overseas.
